

THE BLESSING OF FORGIVENESS

We should always have a kind, giving spirit toward others. Yet all too often we only look after ourselves. Maybe you can't seem to forgive even yourself because of the envious way you looked at someone. You thought, "It's not fair that they have it so good." But then you remembered that you should have thought of that other person as a friend rather than an enemy in your way.

It can be even more damaging to a relationship if we outright betray someone's trust. If someone confides in you only to have you spread around a bad report about them it can be really hurtful. It hurts their reputation, and also your relationship with them. When we sin against someone else like that it can leave a lasting scar. We can feel separated from people who ought to be friends and family. And, even if they don't ask for any extra space, we may be tempted to avoid them.

Rebellion breaks a relationship. It is a sin against the love that the other person wants and expects from you. What is worse is that when we hurt those around us, it also strains our relationship with God. At the same time that we have rebelled against a friend, a family member, or a coworker, we have also rebelled against God. God wants us to love others to the degree that he has loved us. He wants us to protect others' property, good name, and health. It's how we show God that we cherish our relationship with him.

The amazing thing is that even in our rebellion God restores what we have bent or broken. He comes to forgive our rebellion and put our relationship with him back the way it ought to be. In Christ, nothing stands between us and our holy God because he has made us holy. What a gift you have that God has made a relationship with you. It is founded on Christ's perfect life of love. It is secured by the punishment Christ went through--a death that pays for every rebellion. Cherish this forgiveness you have in Christ.

And the more you appreciate the relationship you now share with God the more you will be able to treat others as he has treated you. God gives you real power to love in amazing ways. He teaches, equips, and empowers you to live and love like Christ. Walk in God's forgiveness. It's a great blessing!

Lord God, may your peace always show in the way we relate to those around us. Amen.
